Important – please read!

It is the Competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the Rules and Regulations for USCSS™. [USCSS-Rules-Ver.-3.0.pdf](#)

This is a VARIABLE Trial. 3 legs per element are required to earn a title. Per Section 15.1D "...titles will only be awarded following the traditional progression of Novice. - Interm.-Advanced- Senior-Master." If you have any questions, after checking the rule book contact the Trial Secretary for additional clarification.

SAFETY: All dogs must be on a 6' or shorter leash when not participating in a search. EVERY dog MUST maintain a minimum of 6' distance from all other dogs at ALL TIMES.

AWARDS: Ribbons will not be mailed. A qualifying ribbon will be given at the end of your run. 1st - 4th place per class. Titles will not be awarded for the team competing at a higher level without progression through the levels starting from novice. All legs earned at a higher level, without previously earned titles at the lower levels, are banked and will be waiting for the team once the progression is complete. Keep in mind that the progression through the levels in variable vs. classic is separate. HIGH in Trial, High Champion & High Rescue Awards are NOT offered as there is a 125 run limit. # Tabs are awarded in lieu of title ribbons beyond the first title. ie. CN would receive a New Title ribbon; CN2 would receive a #2 tab. DDN would receive a New Title ribbon; DDN2 would receive a #2 tab.

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!: Dispose of waste in appropriate containers. Do NOT let your dog pee on items we have to touch!

DESTRUCTION/DAMAGE to Search Area: Section 17.6B - Handlers will be expected to make financial reparations to the event host or owner of the item that will cover the cost of replacement or repair to the damaged item. ie. vehicles, furniture.

COLLARS & LEASHES: Flexi/retractable leads are **ONLY permitted during a search**. Choke chains, prong collars or halti/head collars are NOT permitted during searches. Leashes of any length may be used while the dog is participating in a search. Dogs MUST be switched over to a 6' length or shorter leash when outside of the search area.

COVID 19 Protocols: Whatever you're comfortable with.

CRATING: Crating is from your vehicle. Just remember, it's Florida, it's HOT!

ELIGIBLE DOGS: The following dogs are eligible to compete in USCSS™ events:

- Dogs 6-months of age or older
- Dogs of any breed, purebred or mixed breed
- Blind, deaf or dogs with amputations or who use ambulatory carts
- Bitches in season, but they must wear panties and be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. If bringing a bitch in season, **please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial** and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing

FOOD: Bring your lunch as the closest store is 5+ miles away.

PAYMENTS & WAIVERS: Checks made out to **BCDTC** and mailed with the Waiver to **Marilyn Strout, 3794 Long Grove Ln., Port Orange, FL 32129**. Both must be received *within 5 days AFTER Date of Entry Confirmation* Email from Trial Secretary. **If not received on time, the competitor falls to the bottom of the entry list until 2pm on Closing Date.**

REACTIVE DOGS: **Brevard County Dog Training Club** accepts the entries of reactive dogs in USCSS™ trials. These dogs have to be crated in the handler's car. Reactive dogs will be run first or last in the trial and all other dogs must be crated while the reactive dogs are preparing for the search. A 10-minute break will be given after the reactive dogs have run and are again crated to give the other teams time to prepare for their runs. USCSS™ suggests that reactive dogs wear red bandannas.

REFUNDS & EVENT CANCELLATION: No refunds allowed after the pre-entry closing date except in the case of injured dogs (**Veterinary note required**). Refund will be 50% and those seeking a refund must request by 8:30 am on the day of the trial. Vet note must be received by Monday after trial and can be sent to the Trial Chairman. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. In the event of an "act of God" such as flood, hurricane or fire, or civil disturbances or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee, the event may be canceled or postponed. We will make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation or postponement.

SCHEDULE: Master - Novice – Intermediate – Advanced - Senior. Judge assignments & run order will be determined after the closing date on the day of the trial. Anticipated Check In time "around 7:30 am" with a CSD Briefing at 7:50 am. First Dog Team(s) on the line at 8:00 am. Staggered Arrival Times are planned.

NO SMOKING/VAPING: At this facility or on the grounds. The trial will be held indoors & outdoors. Surfaces used for searches will be wood, metal, concrete, dirt, and grass.

Steps for Joining USCSS™, Registering Dog and Entering this Trial

3. Competitors will then receive the 1st email confirmation email with details regarding their entry. They will then receive a 2nd email confirmation with PAYMENT DETAILS from the Trial Secretary mitchstrout@yahoo.com and instructions on how to submit payment for their entry. Payments will be sent directly to the Trial Secretary, not USCSS™. The confirmation email will specify WHERE to mail payment. Competitors should note that their spot in the trial will only be held once payment is made.
