AWARDS

Ribbons must be picked up the day of the trial, they will not be mailed or delivered by the trial host.

Dogs must be entered in and Q in a minimum of 5 classes at each trial to be eligible for any HIT awards 2nd - 4th place Overall 1st - 4th place per Class

Dogs do not need to be entered in Detection Dog Extreme in order to qualify for HIT

Number tabs will be provided, in lieu of title ribbons for teams earning titles beyond their first. For example, a team will receive a "2" tab when the team earns their VN2, or a "3" tab for a DDDI3 title. The tabs would be in place of title ribbons.
