IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ!

To earn your Classic title, you need to enter and qualify in ALL 4 classes designated for the classic title in one trial. If you do NOT qualify in all 4, your qualifying scores will still earn you a leg toward your Element titles. Also, if you already have your Classic title at a level, you may still enter all 4 elements at that level and get legs towards your Element titles and overall Variable Title at that level. Policy/Event Cancellation:

No refunds allowed after the pre-entry closing date except in the case of injured dogs (<u>Veterinary note required</u>). Refund will be 50% and those seeking a refund must request by 8:30 am on the day of the trial. Vet note must be received by Monday after trial and can be sent to the Trial Chairman.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. In the event of an "act of God" such as flood or fire, or civil disturbances or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee, the event may be canceled. We will make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation.

Number of Entries:

100 runs per Judge in this trial | Multiple dogs allowed, 2nd dog must run FEO. Titling dog must be run first | For Exhibition Only entries taken | Day of Show entries allowed if there is room.

Registration Entry and Closing:

Entries will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis, of all entries received between the opening and closing date.

Opening Date: March 1, 2019

Closing Date: April 13, 2019

Payments and signed waivers must be received by 6:00 pm on the closing date of April 13, 2019. If not received on time, the competitor forfeits the on-line entry and must do day of entry (if trial is not full) with the increased entry fee.

Dogs must have valid USCSS™ registration numbers to compete in this trial. You can and should (whenever possible) register online and follow the payment instructions noted on the confirmation. Steps for Joining USCSS™, Registering Dog and Entering this Trial:

- 1. All competitors must become a member of USCSS™, which is free. Competitors may join here: http://members.uscaninescentsports.com/signup.
- **3.** When logged into their account on the USCSS™ website, competitors may then scroll down to the "LOCAL EVENTS" section, find the trial they are interested in entering and click on the ENTER button.
- **4.** Competitors may then select which dog they are entering and select which Classes and/or Games they are entering.
- 5. Competitors will then receive a confirmation email with details regarding their entry and instructions on how to submit payment for their entry. All payments will be sent directly to the trial host, not USCSS™. The confirmation email will specify how payment will be made (e.g. via PayPal, mailed check, etc.). Competitors should note that their spot in the trial will only be held once payment is made.

The order of Novice classes will be container, interior, vehicle, exterior.

Followed by the intermediate level.

Running order will be sent with final confirmation.

Exhibitors are responsible for anything that is said at the briefing regardless of whether you attend it.

Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring your entries are correct. Any changes to Exhibitor's entry are to be emailed to the secretary before the closing date.

ANY CHANGES REQUESTED DAY OF TRIAL WILL BE CHARGED A \$5 FEE.

AWARDS:

Dogs must be entered in a minimum of 4 classes at each trial to be eligible for any HIT awards. All ribbons must be picked up day of trial. No ribbons will be mailed out.

Exhibitor Information: The following dogs are eligible to compete in USCSS™ events:

- Dogs 6-months of age or older
- Dogs of any breed, purebred or mixed breed
- Blind, deaf or dogs with amputations or who use ambulatory carts
- Bitches in season but they must wear panties and be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. If bringing a bitch in season, <u>please</u> <u>inform the trial secretary prior to the trial</u> and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

Reactive Dogs:

Canine Star Training Academy accepts the entries of reactive dogs in USCSS trials. These dogs may not be crated in the general crating area and may have to be crated in the handler's car. Reactive dogs will be run first in the trial and all other dogs must be crated while the reactive dogs are in the building. A 10-minute break will be given after the reactive dogs have run and are again crated to give the other teams time to prepare for their runs. USCSS™ suggests that reactive dogs wear red bandannas.

Leash and Collars:

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. Flexi/retractable leads are not permitted on USCSS™ sanctioned trial grounds. No choke chains, prong collars or halti/head collars are permitted.

Leashes of any length may be used while the dog is participating in a run during a class, but they must be switched over to a 6' length leash or shorter when outside the search area.

There is **NO SMOKING** in this facility or on the grounds. The trial will be held indoors and outdoors. Surfaces used for searches will be rubber matting, concrete, dirt, and grass.

CRATING: There will be crating space available inside the building

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!

Dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building. Do **NOT** let your dog pee on items we have to touch!
