To earn your Classic title, you need to enter and q in ALL 4 classes in one trial AND RUN and Q in the Exterior class #1. If you do NOT qualify in all 4, your qualifying scores will still earn you a leg towards your Element titles for your Variable Novice title. In addition, if you already have your Novice Classic title, you may still enter all 4 Novice elements and get legs towards your Element titles and overall Variable Title in Novice.

Refund Policy/Event Cancellation

No refunds allowed after the pre-entry closing date except in the case of injured dogs (<u>Veterinary note</u> <u>required</u>). Refund will be 50% and those seeking a refund must request by 8:30 am on the day of the trial. Vet note must be received by Monday after trial and can be sent to the Trial Chairman.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. In the event of an "act of God' such as flood or fire, or civil disturbances or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee, the event may be canceled. We will make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation.

Number of Entries:

150 runs per Judge per trial | Multiple dogs allowed, 2nd dog must run FEO. Titling dog must be run first | For Exhibition Only entries taken | Day of Show entries allowed if there is room.

Registration Entry and Closing:

Entries will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis, of all entries received between the opening date, which is December 1, 2018 and the closing date, which is February 1, 2019 (or when trial fills).

Dogs must have valid USCSS[™] registration numbers to compete in this trial. You can and should (whenever possible) register online and follow the payment instructions noted on the confirmation. Steps for Joining USCSS[™], Registering Dog and Entering this Trial:

- 1. All competitors must become a member of USCSS[™], which is free. Competitors may join here: <u>http://members.uscaninescentsports.com/signup</u>.
- 2. Competitors must then register their dog(s) through the USCSS[™] website. Each registration includes a one-time \$25.00 fee. Competitors may register their dogs here:

- 3. When logged into their account on the USCSS[™] website, competitors may then scroll down to the "LOCAL EVENTS" section, find the trial they are interested in entering and click on the ENTER button.
- **4.** Competitors may then select which dog they are entering and select which Classes and/or Games they are entering.
- 5. Competitors will then receive a confirmation email with details regarding their entry and instructions on how to submit payment for their entry. All payments will be sent directly to the trial host, not USCSS[™]. The confirmation email will specify how payment will be made (e.g. via PayPal, mailed check, etc.). Competitors should note that their spot in the trial will only be held once payment is made.

Schedule:

- 9:30am: Reactive Dogs followed by <u>10 minute</u> break then Volunteer Novice Dogs Run followed by 1st novice dog on line

Exhibitor Information: The following dogs are eligible to compete in USCSS[™] events:

Dogs 6-months of age or older

- Dogs of any breed, purebred or mixed breed
- Blind, deaf or dogs with amputations or who use ambulatory carts.
- Bitches in season but they must wear panties and be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. If bringing a bitch in season, <u>please inform</u> <u>the trial secretary prior to the trial</u> and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

Reactive Dogs

Canine Star Training Academy accepts the entries of reactive dogs in USCSS trials. These dogs may not be crated in the general crating area and may have to be crated in the handler's car. Reactive dogs will be run first in the trial and all other dogs must be crated while the reactive dogs are in the building. A 10 minute break will be given after the reactive dogs have run and are again crated to give the other teams time to prepare for their runs. USCSS™ suggests that reactive dogs wear red bandannas.

Leash and Collars:

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. Flexi/retractable leads are not permitted on USCSS[™] sanctioned trial grounds. No choke chains, prong collars or halti/head collars are permitted. Leashes of any length may be used while the dog is participating in a run during a Class, but they must be switched over to a 6' length leash when outside of the search area.

There is **NO SMOKING** in this facility or on the grounds. The trial will be held indoors, and outdoors. Surfaces used for searches will be rubber matting, concrete, dirt, and grass.

CRATING There will be crating space available inside the building.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!

Dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building. Do NOT let your dog pee on items we have to touch!
