** Search areas are NOT nested. Competitors with multiple dogs in the same level may only run one dog for a title in each of the classes. Any additional dogs running in the same class must be run FEO.**

Entries will be taken on a first-come-first-served basis of all entries received. *Pre-entries close on September 20th, 2025.*

Dogs must have valid USCSS™ registration numbers to compete in this trial.
