**Important – Please Read!**

It is the Competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the Rules and Regulations for USCSS™.

This is a **CLASSIC Trial**. You **MUST** enter all 4 elements at a single level in order to earn the Classic Title. However, any and all Q's earned will also count towards the general USCSS Variable title requirements. If you have any questions, after checking the rule book contact the Trial Secretary for additional clarification.

**SAFETY:** All dogs must be on a 6' or shorter leash when not participating in a search. EVERY dog **MUST** maintain a minimum of 6' distance from all other dogs at ALL TIMES.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will not be mailed.

- A qualifying ribbon will be given at the end of your run.
- 1st-4th place per class.
- Title ribbons are given upon earning the 3rd qualifying leg in an element or game, or upon completion of a level. See Section 15.1D for further explanation.
- HIT- HIGH in TRIAL 1st thru 4th place will be offered at all levels.

**CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!:** Dispose of waste in appropriate containers. Do NOT let your dog pee on items we have to touch! We are guests on this property, please be respectful.

**DESTRUCTION/DAMAGE** to Search Area: Section 17.7B -Handlers will be expected to make financial reparations to the event host or owner of the item that will cover the cost of replacement or repair to the damaged item. ie. vehicles, furniture.

**COLLARS & LEASHES:** Flexi/retractable leads are **ONLY** permitted during a search. Choke chains, prong collars or halti/head collars are **NOT** permitted during searches. Leashes of any length may be used while the dog is participating in a search. Dogs **MUST** be switched over to a 6' length or shorter leash when outside of this search area.

**CRATING:** Crating is at your vehicle. Crating **MUST BE** in an enclosed crate. Open top crates and exercise pens (xpens) are **NOT PERMITTED** for safety reasons. Be prepared to provide shade and water throughout the trial.

**ELIGIBLE DOGS:** The following dogs are eligible to compete in USCSS™ events:

- Dogs 6-months of age or older
- Dogs of any breed, purebred or mixed breed
- Blind, deaf or dogs with amputations or who use ambulatory carts
- Bitches in season, but they must wear panties and be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing

**INELIGIBLE DOGS:** See Section 6.4 of the Rulebook.

**FOOD:** Pizza will be provided for lunch but there are other restaurants and fast food options in town if you prefer.

**REACTIVE DOGS:** Sniff Happens accepts the entries of reactive dogs in USCSS™ trials. Reactive dogs will be run first or last in the trial and all other dogs must be crated while the reactive dogs are preparing for the search. A 10-minute break will be given after the reactive dogs have run and are again crated to give the other teams time to prepare for their runs. USCSS™ suggests that reactive dogs wear red bandanas. Please notify the Trial Secretary, in advance, if you have a reactive dog.

**CANCELLATION:** Full refund minus \$10 administrative fee for all cancellations up to November 21, 2026. 50% refund after November 21, 2026 if the host can fill your spot. No refund after December 5, 2026. No refund in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition on the day of the event.

**SCHEDULE:** Final Judge assignments & run order will be determined after the closing date. Check In time 8:15am with a CSD Briefing at 8:30 am. First Dog Team(s) on the line after the briefing. Details will be emailed two weeks before the trial.

**SMOKING/VAPING/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** are NOT permitted on the grounds at this facility.

**SITE:** The trial will be held on private property indoors & outdoors. Surfaces used for searches will be wood, metal, concrete, dirt, and grass.

#### **Steps for Joining USCSS™, Registering Dog and Entering this Trial:**

1. All competitors must become a member of USCSS™, which is free. Competitors may join here: <https://members.uscaninescentsports.com/signup>
2. Competitors must then register their dog(s) through the USCSS™ website. Each registration includes a one-time \$25.00 fee. Competitors may register their dogs here: <http://members.uscaninescentsports.com/dog/register>
3. When logged into their account on the USCSS™ website, competitors may then scroll down to the "LOCAL EVENTS" section, find the trial they are interested in entering and click on the ENTER button.

5. Competitors will then receive a confirmation email with details regarding their entry and instructions on how to submit payment for their entry.
