### **Registration Entry and Closing:**

- Pre-entries close on April 17, 2019 or when the trial fills.
- Entries will be awarded in order of receipt.
- When payment is received by the host, you will receive an e-mail confirmation from Living with Dogs with information about volunteering and lunch.





- All dogs must have valid USCSS registration numbers to compete in this trial. All handlers must be members of USCSS to compete in this trial.
- Vehicle, Container & Exterior classes will NOT be nested searches. You will be able to run two
  dogs for titles if the dogs are at different levels. If you are running dogs in the same level, titling
  dogs must be run first, FEO dogs can be run after titling dogs.
- Nested searches will be used for interior classes in this trial.
- No refunds will be made for withdrawal after April 17; prior to that date a \$25 processing fee
  will be withheld.
- No refund will be made if the team is absent, disqualified or excused by a judge for any reason.
