Time Frames

Check-in time for Intermediate is 7:45 a.m. Briefing time is 8:00-8:15 a.m. First dog on the line at 8:30am We are starting early in an effort to beat the full heat of the day. Senior, Game check-in times TBD. **Dogs must have valid USCSS™ registration numbers to compete in this trial**. Handler may, space permitting, run multiple dogs; dogs competing for titles must run first; For Exhibition Only (FEO) dogs run afterwards.

Steps for Joining USCSS[™], Registering Dog and Entering this Trial:

1. All competitors must become a member of USCSS[™], which is free. Competitors may join here: <u>http://members.uscaninescentsports.com/signup</u>

2. Competitors must then register their dog(s) through the USCSS[™] website. Each registration includes a one-time \$25.00 fee.

3. When logged into their account on the USCSS[™] website, competitors may then scroll down to the "LOCAL EVENTS" section, find the trial they are interested in entering and click on the enter button.

4. Competitors may then select which dog they are entering and select which classes and/or games they are entering.

5. Competitors will then receive a confirmation email with details regarding their entry and instructions on how to submit payment for their entry. All payments will be sent directly to the trial host, not USCSS[™]. The confirmation email will specify how payment will be made (it will be via PayPal). Competitors should note that their spot in the trial will only be held once payment is made.

Parking: Please follow directions from Parking Lot volunteers. The spaces in the lots are very tight, so smaller vehicles are recommended, no campers or RVs. There is no reactive dog parking at this site.

Trial Venue Information: The school is in the middle of an urban residential area and the residents do like to walk their dogs, a good thing, but may make for a busy time on some of the walk ways where we will have potty areas. So please be vigilant as you potty your dogs. Do not let them potty on lawns or property that humans may touch.

The trial will be held indoors and outdoors. Surfaces used for search will be carpet, wooden floors, tile, concrete, black top, wood chips, dirt, grass and gravel. There may be medium walks to some of the search areas. This is a multi level school but it has an elevator to assist both the human and dog participants if needed, as well as ramps and stairs.

Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. In the event of an "Act of God" such as flood, fire or civil disturbances, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee, the event may be canceled. We will make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation.

Unentered Dogs

Unentered dogs must remain in the competitor's vehicle during the trial day. There will be ample potty areas, but unentered dogs should not be allowed to "play", exercise, or train on the trial ground. Please if at all possible leave unentered dogs home.

<u>Smoking</u>

Smoking is not allowed on this trial site, including the use of e-cigarettes

DOG INFORMATION

Dog Policies

- All dogs must be on a 6' leash at all times when not being tested. NO flexi-leashes while not participating in a competition search.
- Dogs that need space from dogs may wear a red bandana, provided by the dog's

handler, to help signal others that the dog needs extra space from dogs.

- Dogs will be toileted in designated areas and handlers must pick-up and dispose of waste.
- Dogs and handlers must stay in designated areas to avoid contaminating testing space, interrupting a test, or from viewing any part of the testing.
- Competitors should expect to keep their dogs confined in a crate or vehicle when not competing. The logistics of a trial typically do not allow for dogs to hang out on leash in between searches. Competitors should plan to provide their own shade using canopies or shade cloths. Fans or other cooling devices are recommended.
- Refer to Location Details (above) for information on unentered dogs.

Females in Season

Will be allowed to run wearing "pants" at the very end of the running orders after all other dogs have been judged. Females in season will be parked and pottied in areas separate from the other dogs while at the trial if the location logistics permit. Handlers must contact mailto:mntsea23@gmail.com so plans can be made for the dog.

Self-cleaning trial. Please pick up after your dog. Bags can be deposited in outside garbage cans.

Sportsmanship

All competitors/handlers and spectators are expected to follow the rules of the USCSS and demonstrate good sportsmanship. This includes making sure the hide placements are unknown to the handler prior to testing and kept secret from other competitors. Please do not discuss hide placement or any details of a dog's performance that may

provide information or clues to other handlers or may be overheard. Please do not post any information on Social Media until all searches have been completed for the day.
